MDHHS will begin requiring provider group modifiers on all encounters for all non-team-based services beginning in SFY 2022 with exceptions for the following services:

•Select Supports Services – H2015, T2027, H2014, and T2015 were identified by workgroups as not requiring a provider group modifier because the rate paid to providers to render these services does not vary by provider group (i.e., providers with a bachelor's degree or higher get paid the same as providers without a bachelor's degree).

•ACT – MDHHS is requesting to include the provider group modifier on all encounters for this team-based service to better monitor who on the ACT team is providing the face-to-face contact.
