Directions to St. Clair County Community Mental Health:

North End Directions: Take M-25 South which becomes Pine Grove Ave/I-69BL/I-94BL. Turn right onto 10th Ave. [10th Ave. turns into 10th St.] Turn right onto Electric Ave. (Lake Huron Medical Center will be on the right). Continue to follow Electric Ave. to CMH (3111 Electric Ave. is just past 16th St.).

I-69 Directions: Take I-69 East all the way to Port Huron. When approaching the I-94 junction, the I-69 business loop starts. The I-69 freeway will end at 24th St. and become a one-way (Oak St.). Follow Oak St. to 16th St. and turn right. Take 16th St. to Electric Ave. Turn right on Electric Ave. and CMH is on your immediate right.

I-94 Directions: Take I-94 all the way to Port Huron. Exit at the Downtown Exit (I-69 business loop Exit 271). It is the next exit after the Range Rd./Dove St. Exit. The I-69 freeway will end at 24th St. and become a one-way (Oak St.). Follow Oak St. to 16th St. and turn right. Take 16th St. to Electric Ave. Turn right on Electric Ave. and CMH is on your immediate right.
